

ESTABLISHMENT OF VILLAGES.

Edmonton, Wednesday, July 6, 1910.

Under the provisions of The Village Act, His Honour the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order the establishment of the south-west quarter of Section 19 Township 53 Range 24 west of the 4th Meridian as a Village; that the Village be given the name of West Edmonton; that Samuel Irwin, of Elm Park, via Edmonton, be Returning Officer for the purpose of acting at the election of the first Council of the Village; and that the meeting for nomination of candidates for the office of Councillor shall be held on Tuesday, the 5th day of July, 1910.
