In the matter of "The Public Utilities Act":

And in the matter of an application by Clara Elizabeth Russell respecting the fractional south-east quarter of section 17, township 52, range 24, west of the fourth meridian.

Upon the application of Clara Elizabeth Russell, the registered owner of the property hereinafter described; upon reading the consent of The City of Edmonton, the consent of the Municipal District of Strathcona, No. 83, and the consent of The Commercial Life Assurance Company, and upon reading the other material filed:

It is ordered that the following lands, namely:

The fractional south-east quarter of section 17, township 52, range 24, west of the fourth meridian, lying within the original boundaries of the Papaschase Indian Reserve, being those portions covered and not covered by waters of the Two Hills Lake as shown on Plan of subdivision of said Reserve showing resurvey in October, 1890, containing 107 acres more or less:

shall cease to form part of the said City of Edmonton as and from the day of the date hereof, and that the same be added to and form a part of the Municipal District of Strathcona, No. 83:

And it is further ordered that the said parcel of land shall no longer be liable for the payment of any debenture indebtedness to which it was subject when comprised in the City of Edmonton, and shall no longer be liable for debenture rates or taxes imposed in respect of such indebtedness.
