#### **PROCLAMATION**

To ALL to Whom these presents shall come. GREETING

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of DEVON has expressed to the Minister of Municipal Affairs the desire of the said Village to be formed into a Town; and

Whereas the said Village contains over seven hundred inhabitants; and

Whereas the aforesaid desire has been approved by more than two-thirds of the electors of the Village voting thereon; and

Whereas the Secretary-Treasurer of the Village has furnished satisfactory proof of compliance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act with respect to the required formalities in the formation of a Town;

NOW KNOW YE that by and with the advice and consent of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Alberta, by virtue of the provisions of The Town and Village Act, being Chapter 150 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, and amendments thereto, and of all other power and authority whatsoever in us vested in that behalf, We have ordered and declared and do hereby proclaim the forming of the Village of DEVON into a Town, and that on and after the date of this Proclamation the Village of DEVON shall be known and designated as the Town of DEVON and shall consist of the following area:

## Firstly:

That part of section 2, township 51, range 26, west of the fourth meridian. lying south of the North Saskatchewan River;

### Secondly:

The north-west and south-east quarters of section 34, township 50, range 26, west of the fourth meridian;

## Thirdly:

The south half of the south-west quarter of legal subdivision 10 of section 34, township 50, range 26, west of the fourth meridian; and in accordance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act, the present Council of the Village shall, until the first Monday in March next following the date of the Proclamation, be deemed to be the Council of the Town of Devon, and that the said Council shall prepare for the election of a Mayor and six Councillors to take office on a date to be set by Ministerial Order under authority of Section 5 of The Town and Village Act in that behalf, that the terms of office of the Councillors so elected shall be governed by the provisions of Section 49 of The Town and Village Act, and that those entitled to vote shall be as set out in Section 104 of The Town and Village Act.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent, and the Great Seal of Our Province of Alberta to be hereunto affixed
