

Edmonton, Tuesday, June 2, 1931.

His Honour the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order (under the authority of The Village Act, being Chapter 54 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1927, in that behalf) that the Village of Newcastle be and is hereby dissolved, and that the lands which were within the boundaries of the said village be and are hereby added to Improvement District No. 276, and be made subject to taxation under The Improvement District Act, being Chapter 53 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1927, commencing with the current year; further, that the arrears of village taxes outstanding against the lands in the said village, from assessments levied by the village, shall remain a charge against the said lands and be payable as taxes due Improvement District No. 276, in the same way as if they had been levied by the said Improvement District; and further, that all tools, implements, or other property formerly belonging to the said village shall now become the property of the Department of Municipal Affairs in trust for the said Improvement District No. 276 (this order dissolving the said village to be effective as from May 21st, 1931).
