

BYLAW NO. 26-1185

BEAVER COUNTY

**A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE RATES OF TAXATION
TO BE LEVIED AGAINST ASSESSABLE PROPERTY
WITHIN BEAVER COUNTY FOR THE 2026 TAXATION YEAR.**

WHEREAS Beaver County has prepared and adopted detailed estimates of the probable revenues and expenditures as required by Sections 242 and 245 of the *Municipal Government Act*, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, as amended, at a Regular Council meeting held April 14, 2026; and

WHEREAS the estimated municipal expenditures and transfers set out in the budget for Beaver County for 2026 total \$34,982,968; and

WHEREAS the estimated municipal revenues and transfers from all sources other than taxation is estimated at \$17,308,970 and the balance of \$17,673,998 is to be raised by general municipal taxation; and

WHEREAS, the Council of Beaver County is required each year to levy on the assessed value of all assessable property, tax rates sufficient to meet the estimated expenditures and the requisitions; and

WHEREAS the Council of Beaver County is authorized to classify assessed property, and to establish different rates of taxation in respect to each class of property, subject to the *Municipal Government Act*; and

WHEREAS the assessed value of all property in Beaver County for the 2026 tax year as shown on the assessment roll is:

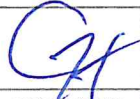

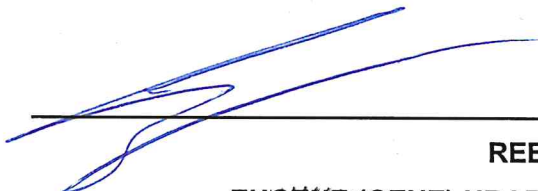
1. That the Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to levy the following rates of taxation on the assessed value of all property as shown on the assessment roll of Beaver County:

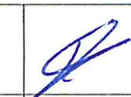
